
NCCP TRANSFER OF QUALIFICATIONS - MED

All coaches must complete the NCCP Make Ethical Decisions (MED) training and/or evaluation.

Upon completing the NCCP MED training, coaches will be able to:

- Analyze a challenging situation and determine if it has moral, legal, or ethical implications; and
- Apply the NCCP Ethical Decision-Making Model to properly respond to situations in a way that is consistent with the NCCP Code of Ethics.

Completion of the NCCP MED **training** is necessary for coaches to maintain **trained** status in any NCCP program.

Once a coach has completed their training, they can test their decision-making skills by completing the NCCP Make Ethical Decisions online evaluation. Successful completion of the evaluation is necessary for coach **certification** in any NCCP program.

Coaches that have completed the NCCP Make Ethical Decisions training, and have it listed on their transcript, will have FREE unlimited attempts to pass the NCCP Make Ethical Decisions online evaluation.

If you have NOT completed the training, the cost of the NCCP Make Ethical Decisions online evaluation is \$85.00, and you only receive 2 attempts to pass the evaluation.

If you have taken the **Gymnastics Foundations Theory course**, MED training is included within the course and you will only be required to complete the online evaluation if you require certified status. After the transfer of qualifications takes effect, coaches will need to complete the following within five years of the transfer taking effect:

1. Coaches who are granted “Trained Transferred” status must complete, at a minimum, **training** in MED; or
2. Coaches who are granted “Certified Transferred” status must complete the MED **evaluation**.

If you fail to complete the above MED requirement within five years, it will result in a “non-renewed” status on your Locker transcript, and you will have to contact Gymnastics Canada or your Provincial/Territorial Organization (PTO) to determine your next steps to renew your certification.
